Book Submission Guidelines

All book must be typed on A4-size paper, using font size 12, 1.5 line spacing, and a single-column layout with a minimum margin of one inch on all sides.

Author Profile Submission: Authors are requested to submit a brief profile in a separate Word document, comprising approximately 10–15 lines. Please include a recent passport-size photograph along with the profile.

Book Chapter Submission Guidelines

All book chapters must be typed on A4-size paper, using font size 12, 1.5 line spacing, and a single-column layout with a minimum margin of one inch on all sides. Authors are required to submit a single Word file containing the following details:

- Title of the Book
- Author's Name
- Designation (e.g., Position, Institution/University)
- Contact Details (Phone Number and Email ID)
- Abstract and Keywords
- Introduction
- Main Chapter Content
- References

Language:

References

References to the literature cited for the manuscript should be numbered in order of appearance in the manuscript and cited in the text with superscript numbers. The reference number should follow the following format.

For book Format: Author(s) of article (surname initials). Title of the manuscript. Journal title. Year of publication; volume number (issue number): page numbers.

For Books and other monograph Format: Author AB, Author BB, Author CC. Title of Book. Ed, Vol, Publisher, City, year, page numbers.
